# The Pastor Writes

**WE NEED YOU!** **Extended Teaching Care** takes place during both worship services on Sunday mornings. Our volunteers take turns, usually only once a quarter, caring for our preschoolers, ages birth through 3 years. We have four groups during the early and the late services – babies, one's, two's and three's. That means we have eight sessions each Sunday morning with 16 volunteers (two per room) to care for the children. So in a 13-week quarter of the year, we need 208 volunteers for ETC. That is a lot of volunteers, and **we are in need of some now.** Right now, our ETC volunteer list includes 162 wonderful, caring volunteers! I am so very thankful for each and every one of them! 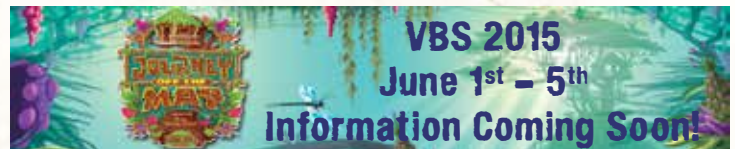
