Mountain T.O.P. | July 19 - 22, 2018

Harrisburg has been going to serve with Mountain T.O.P. for several years. What started out as a singles mission trip has turned into a yearly tradition for several of our members. We want to offer our church family an opportunity to experience the joy of serving the people of the Cumberland Mountains.

During Family Weekend, we want to offer you a unique opportunity to serve families in the Cumberland Mountains through working and worshipping with your own family. Here, you will find a place to work on replenishing, renewing and reclaiming the needs of your family.

Logistically, families arrive Thursday evening, work in the community on Friday and Saturday and leave Sunday morning after breakfast. Projects are based on the skills of family members and the expressed needs of the families we work with. On Friday and Saturday evening, we gather together for worship. Other programming options include group morning devotionals and/or personal reflection time.
