Matthew 8:28-34

What does this teach us about Satan?

1. Satan's goal is death and destruction
2. Satan relishes in and rules over the unclean
3. Satan's time is limited

What does this teach us about Jesus?

1. Jesus is the Son of God
2. Jesus has authority over His enemies
3. Jesus has an appointed time

What does this mean for you?

1. Accept Jesus as Lord
2. Be a witness of what Christ has done
3. Be pure to be used by the Lord

2 Timothy 2:20–24 (CSB)

“²⁰ Now in a large house there are not only gold and silver vessels, but also those of wood and clay; some for honorable use and some for dishonorable. ²¹ So if anyone purifies himself from anything dishonorable, he will be a special instrument, set apart, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work. ²² Flee from youthful passions, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart. ²³ But reject foolish and ignorant disputes, because you know that they breed quarrels. ²⁴ The Lord's servant must not quarrel, but must be gentle to everyone, able to teach, and patient.”

4. Be gracious and forgiving to others

2. There is no one so far from God or consumed by sin that Jesus can't reach them
3. Every Christian's testimony is that Jesus set me free
